Development Update

Mayor Etheredge and Town Attorney C.D. Rhodes recently had a phone conference with Mr. Wayne Tilson, developer of the IGA Grocery Store. The Mayor had concerns on the delay of the project and wanted to discuss it with Mr. Tilson.

Mr. Tilson stated that after lengthy deliberation, his company has put the financial package together to start the project. Banks and mortgage companies are very cautious when lending monies of large amounts, especially with small towns. As we spoke, Mr. Tilson and the mortgage company were putting the final pieces of the loan together.

Mr. Tilson stated that construction should begin by the end of March. The development will consist of a Morning Fresh IGA and several additional businesses.

The Mayor realizes how important this development is to the Town and will continue to monitor the progress going forward.
