

# **Water Billing**

The billing schedule is as follows:

- Bills are mailed out the first of the month
- Bills are due the 20th of the same month
- Late fee of \$10 will be applied after the 20<sup>th</sup>
- An additional late fee of \$25 will be applied after 10:00AM on the 27<sup>th</sup> and you will be subject to disconnection.
- Please be aware that tampering or removing a lock from a meter is in violation of State Law. You could be charged fees and/or punishable by law.

If you do not receive a bill, please contact our office for your account balance. We do not print duplicate bills. Failure to receive a bill does not excuse non-payment. You can also choose to have your bill emailed to you. We will send out reminders via automated phone calls to those who have not paid. Please make sure your phone number has been updated with our office. Automated reminders will come from phone number (803) 471-2229.

## **Ordinance Spotlight**

As many of you know we have an Ordinance Inspector to aid in the beautification of our town. We are working diligently with residents to maintain the standards of our town ordinances, by utilizing two local churches and United Way to assist property owners with cleanup and repair needs. For information contact Elizabeth Roddam at Town Hall. The Town of Jackson has several ordinances in place with the intent of ensuring the beautification of our community, ensuring the health and welfare of its citizens, and maintaining property value.

- The Nuisance Property Ordinance [8.20] specifically looks to reduce any health issues that arise from overgrown yards and debris, or items strewn about a yard. This presents health risks to both the owners and the property and to those living nearby. Those owning the property can be cited and the town may take steps to remedy the issue at the owner's expense.
- Please be aware that Campers and RV's may only be stored on your property and not parked on the street.
   Inhabiting a camper on your property is in violation of the zoning ordinance. Junk, abandoned, or derelict vehicles [8.28] can become an unsightly issue in the community as well.
- No one can live/reside in a RV or camper in any property zone. [23-05 § 4-122]
- Animal owners must maintain control of their animals and not allow them to freely roam. [6.04] Animals must be restrained and if dogs become vicious or out of control, the owner should coordinate with the Aiken County Animal Control Shelter for assistance.
