# **Emergency Generators Coming to Well Sites**

Contractors are gearing up to begin the installation of emergency generators at both of the Town's well sites. This important upgrade will help ensure reliable water service during power outages and is a key part of strengthening our utility infrastructure.

The project is being funded through a grant from the South Carolina Rural Infrastructure Authority (SC RIA), and we are grateful for their support in making this improvement possible.

Residents may notice some activity around the well locations as preparations get underway.
